





✓Strengths:

- Very detailed for 436 occupations
- Commitment from PES/EURES

✓Weaknesses:

- Method varies between countries
- No surpluses reported in Ireland, Malta, Italy, Poland and Switzerland





Main findings additional UWV-analysis for the Netherlands

- For 64% (125) of the Dutch shortage occupations, at least 1 other European country experiences a surplus of staff
- For the remaining 36% (69) of the Dutch shortage occupations, no other European country experiences a surplus of staff (nurses, programmers etc.)
- The lower the level of the Dutch shortage occupation, the more countries with surpluses
- Shortages exist in, on average, 6 other European countries for the 194 Dutch shortage occupations
